To reach the festival: From the north or south, take exit 60 from I-135 and travel west on Kansas Ave. (US 56). For parking and shuttle service, turn right on Maxwell and left on First Street. For reserved and handicapped parking (with a valid permit), go north on Hartup, then east on Simpson to the Water Park lot near Festival Gate A.

Shuttle service:

Provided free from McPherson High School. Passengers are let off at Gate C. You may also walk from the high school parking lot and enter at Gate B. Shuttles will run Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
